- Swing & night workers OK
- Couples OK – no kids, sorry.

### **REQUIRES:**

- Valid, legal picture I.D.
- 15 hours of in-house work each week
- Saving \$80 each week (\$25 if on GAU, \$45 if on SSI)
- Rent is \$10 out of pocket each week
- Sobriety on premises. No drug use at all.
- No smoking in the building
- Your participation in management.
